## REGISTER FOR A LEED WORKSHOP AS AN ARIZONA CHAPTER MEMBER

Thank you for registering for the LEED Workshop in Prescott, AZ on August 21, 2009. Please follow the directions below to complete your discounted registration (before 8/4/2009).

1. Go to <http://www.usgbc.org/Workshops/Register>
2. Select “LEED Core Concepts & Strategies” from the drop-down menu and click on “Search.” Scroll down to the Prescott, AZ workshop, and click “[Register]” on the far right.
3. Please proceed to step 5 if you are logged into your USGBC site user account. If you have an existing USGBC site user account and *have yet to log in*, please log in by entering the email address and password that you provided when you created your account. Then click on the “Log In” button and proceed to step 5.
4. If you have not created a site user account, please do the following:
  - a) On the “Login” page, click on the “New to USGBC? Register now. It's free and easy” link beneath the “Login” button.
  - b) Enter your contact information. *Enter your company's Corporate Access ID in the Corporate Access ID field IF your company is a USGBC National Member. If you do not have your company's ID at this time, you can add it later.*
  - c) Click *only once* on the “Submit Your Registration” button at the bottom of the page and proceed to step 5.
5. On the “View Cart” page, verify the title, location and date of the workshop and then scroll to the bottom of the page. Enter the appropriate code in the “Enter New Promotional Code” field in the bottom right-hand corner.
